

Common Core Writing Grade 3

Writing for range of tasks, purposes, and audience in a clear, concise, and organized manner. Students will write opinion, informational, and narrative pieces.

Text Types

- Writes routinely for a range of discipline-specific tasks, purposes, and audiences (narrative, informational, opinion).
- Introduces a topic (opinion, informative) or situation (narrative) and creates an organizational structure, as well as provides closure.
- Develops the topic or opinion with facts, definitions, and reasons.
- Incorporates transitional and temporal words and phrases and dialogue to develop experiences and events in narrative pieces.

Production and Distribution of Writing

With guidance,

- Plans, revises, edits, and uses technology to publish writing (using keyboarding skills)
- Develops and organizes writing that is appropriate to task and purpose.

Research:

- Conducts short research projects.
- Recalls information from experiences or gathers information from print and digital sources.
- Takes notes and sorts evidence into provided categories.
