

Common Core Writing Grade 5

Writing for range of tasks, purposes, and audience in a clear, concise, and organized manner. Students will write opinion, informational, and narrative pieces.

Text Types

- Writes for the range of tasks, purposes, and audiences (narrative, informational, argumentative).
- Provides evidence (reasons, facts, quotations, etc.) to develop their topic.
- Uses narrative techniques (dialogue, description, etc.) to develop characters, setting, and plot.
- Uses a variety of transition words and phrases (Additionally, specifically, in conclusion, etc.) to link ideas, as well as content-based vocabulary to inform about or explain the topics or opinions.

Production and Distribution of Writing

- Produces and publishes clear, concise, and organized writing dependent on task, purpose, and audience that include solid introductions and conclusions using technology.
- Engages in writing process (planning, revising, editing).
- Interacts and collaborates with others using technology (Blogging, Google Docs, etc.).
- Demonstrates keyboarding skills by typing minimum of two pages.

Research:

- Recalls or gathers relevant information from several print and digital sources.
- Summarizes or paraphrases information in notes and finished work.
- Provides a list of sources.
- Uses evidence from text to support research.
